Florence Nightingale was born to English parents in Florence, Italy, on May 12, 1820. Just one year earlier, her older sister, Parthenope, had been born in Naples, Italy, which used to be called Parthenope. When Florence was one year old, the Nightingale family returned to England. They lived in a large house called Lea Hurst in Derbyshire.



Fanny Nightingale, Florence's mother, entertained all the most famous artists, writers, and politicians of the day. For even bigger parties, the Nightingales bought another estate called Embley Park, near London.

My dear Father,
